### **Scope**

This privacy policy is intended to inform the users of this website in accordance with the Datenschutz-Grundverordnung (DSGVO) (eng.: General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)), the Federal Data Protection Act and the Telemedia Act on the type, scope and purpose of the collection and use of personal data by the website operator Arthur Weissbach GmbH Maschinenfabrik.

## **Collection and Use**

Collection and storage of personal data and the nature and purpose of their use

### **a) When visiting the website**

You can basically use our website without revealing your identity. When you visit our website, the browser used on your device automatically sends information to the server of our website. This information is temporarily stored in a so-called log file.

The following information will be collected without your intervention and stored until automated deletion:

- IP-Address of the requesting computer,
- Date and time of access
- Name and URL of the retrieved file,
- Website from which access is made (referrer URL),
- used browser and, if applicable, the operating system of your computer as well as the name of your access provider.

The data mentioned are processed by us for the following purposes:

- Ensuring a smooth connection setup of the website,
- Ensuring comfortable use of our website,
- Evaluation of system security and stability and
- for further administrative purposes.

The legal basis for data processing is Art. 6 Abs. 1 S. 1 lit. f DSGVO. Our legitimate interest follows from the data collection purposes listed above. In no case we use the collected data for the purpose of drawing conclusions about you.



**b) By contacting us via the contact form on our website**

You can use the contact form on our website to contact us.

Your personal data will be entered in an input mask and transmitted to us and stored. If you would like to contact us via our website, we first collect the following data:

- Salutation, first name, family name, Firma, E-Mail-Address
- Street, street number, ZIP Code, city and country
- further information is voluntary

The collection of these data takes place

- to identify you as our customer;
- to process, fulfill and handle your order / request;
- for correspondence with you;
- for invoicing;
- to settle possible liability claims, as well as the assertion of any claims against you;
- to ensure the technical administration of our website;
- to manage our customer data.

The personal data collected by us for the processing of your request will be stored until the expiry of the statutory retention obligation and then deleted, unless we are under Art. 6 Abs. 1 S. 1 lit. c DSGVO due to tax and commercial legal storage and documentation obligations (from HGB, StGB or AO) are obliged to a longer storage or you have agreed in a further storage according to Art. 6 Abs. 1 S. 1 lit. a DSGVO.

**Data Security**

We use the popular SSL (Secure Socket Layer) method within the site visit, in conjunction with the highest level of encryption supported by your browser. In general, this is a 256-bit encryption.



If your browser does not support 256-bit encryption, we'll use 128-bit v3 technology instead. Whether a single page of our website is transmitted in encrypted form is indicated by the closed representation of the key or lock symbol in the bottom status bar of your browser.

We also take appropriate technical and organizational security measures to protect your data against accidental or intentional manipulation, partial or total loss, destruction or against unauthorized access by third parties. Our security measures are continuously improved in line with technological developments.

## **Handling of Personal Data**

Arthur Weissbach GmbH collects, uses and transfers your personal data only if this is permitted by law or if you consent to the collection of data.

Personal information means all information that is used to identify your person and which can be traced back to you - such as your name, e-mail address and telephone number.

## **Handling of Contact Information**

If you contact us through the offered contact options, your details will be stored so that they can be used to process and answer your request. Without your consent, this data will not be disclosed to third parties.

## **Rights of the User: Information, Correction and Deletion**

You have the right:

- in accordance with Art. 15 DSGVO, to request free information about your personal data processed by us. In particular, you can provide information on the processing purposes, the category of personal data, the categories of recipients to whom your data has been disclosed, the



planned retention period, the right to rectification, deletion, limitation of processing or opposition, the existence of a The right to complain, the source of your data, if not collected from me, as well as the existence of automated decision-making including profiling and, where appropriate, meaningful information about their details;

- in accordance with Art. 16 DSGVO, immediately demand the correction of incorrect or complete personal data stored with us;
- in accordance with Art. 17 DSGVO, to demand the deletion of your personal data stored by us, except where the processing is for the exercise of the right to freedom of expression and information, for the fulfillment of a legal obligation, for reasons of public interest or for the assertion, exercise or defense of legal claims is required;
- in accordance with Art. 18 DSGVO to demand the restriction of the processing of your personal data, as far as the accuracy of the data is disputed by you, the processing is unlawful, but you reject their deletion and we no longer need the data, but you this to assert, exercise or defense of legal claims or you have objected to processing in accordance with Art. 21 DSGVO;
- in accordance with Art. 20 DSGVO, your personal data that you have provided to us in a structured, common and machine-readable format or the request transmission to another party responsible;
- pursuant to Art. 7 Abs. 3 DSGVO your once granted consent to revoke against us at any time. As a result, we may not continue the Data processing, which was based on this consent and
- according to Art. 77 DSGVO to complain to a supervisory authority. As a rule, you can contact the supervisory authority of your usual place of residence or work or our company headquarters.

### **Right of Objection**

If your personal data are based on legitimate interests in accordance with Art. 6 Abs. 1 S. 1 lit. f DSGVO are processed, you have the right to file an objection against the processing of your personal data in accordance with Art. 21 DSGVO, provided that there are reasons for this arising from your particular situation or the objection is directed against direct mail. In the latter case, you have a general right of objection, which is implemented by us without specifying any particular situation. If you would like to make
